# Who we are



Since 1949, the Organization of Ibero-American States for Education, Science and Culture (OEI) has been **the leading intergovernmental organization for South-South cooperation in Ibero-America**. With 19 offices across the region and its General Secretariat based in Madrid, OEI has the largest territorial presence in Ibero-America. It consists of 23 member states, along with several observer countries and organizations.

OEI's funding comes from mandatory fees and voluntary contributions from member states' governments, as well as donations from institutions, foundations, multilateral banks, the European Union and other organizations dedicated to improving education, science, and culture in Ibero-America.

OEI brings together the commitment of various stakeholders to achieve shared goals: **regional integration and cohesion, strengthening of our democracies, and improving the well-being of our communities.**
